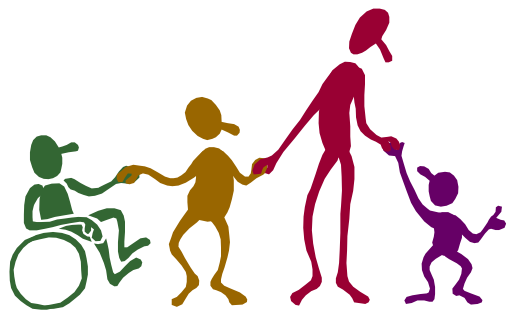


# COMMUNITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE
